Mr. Winn's Report:

 Gearing things currently towards incoming freshman families and new members with long, detailed emails. Attempting to make sure everyone is informed and on the same page.

- Letter jacket tally points have been sent out.
- Solo and Ensemble is coming up. Majority of letter jacket points are earned through Solo and Ensemble.
- Solos are required by Klein ISD as part of the curriculum for all high schools. Boosters pay ½ of the pianist fee. Total fee = \$60 so students are responsible for \$30 that will be collected in January. Piano players are from the faculty at Sam Houston State and will hold 3 rehearsals with each student. Part of the clinician budget is for coaches to come in and work with students individually. They will pull them out during class in the month of January and a portion of February to coach them on their solos. All of these coaches are retired KISD band directors.
- Klein ISD hosts our own Wind Ensemble contest. There is also a UIL contest but Mr. Winn has been notified that our piano players will no longer play at state in an ensemble contest. If your student is interested in continuing on the UIL track to state, please know there are strict requirements and they will have to find and provide their own piano player. Mr. Winn can assist with this process.
- Auditions are coming up. Hoping to hold most auditions during class but this will depend on student
 availability. Some may need to be held after school. This will be a recertification on their second
 semester enrollment. This will either confirm current placement, move them up, or move them down.
- Playoff game schedule will be known week to week. Reminder: If students are in town, they are expected to attend each playoff game.
- Question posed: Are we hosting TCGC this year? Answer: We have 2 contests we will host and they are on the Charms calendar. One is before Spring Break and one is after.
- Question posed: Have you heard back from Southwest? Answer: Southwest was not cheaper and would have cost families a full day in the park.
- Question posed: If playoff games are far away, will the band spend the night? Answer: No, we will always come home immediately after the game ends and will not stay the night.
