## **MR. WINN'S REPORT**

- Thank you to the volunteers
  - We are the gold standard for volunteers
  - Been asked by KC and District administration recently to explain how we make it work
- Everyone is encouraged to show up and support your student at a game and/or competition
- The Baytown competition schedule is out
  - Prelims only one run for all bands
  - Photo make-up times prior to rehearsal
  - Crowd reaction can affect the judges' scores come support!
- Klein Memorial Stadium rehearsal
  - Asked 9/11/23 not to use the stadium lights
  - Possible schedule change in the works
- Eligibility
  - o No refunds issued if student is ineligible
  - If ineligible, miss out on most of the season
  - Mr. Winn has been pairing students with other students for tutorials

- Like football: no pass, no play
- Please talk to friends/parents of other organizations (football, cheer, drill team)
  - We have been late for 2 football games and receiving complaints
  - District has changed bus driver policy to random pool rather than seniority for after-school events which has caused buses to be late (junior high routes, etc. - bus delayed until 6pm at one game)
  - We had a weather delay Mr. Winn informs Mr. Kirk and drill team the moment the band is delayed
  - Decisions are always made with Mr. Kirk and Mr. Winn in constant communication with Mr. Kirk when we are delayed
- Mr. Winn will find more passes for pit crew/props for football games
