#### MR. WINN'S REPORT

- October Break what it means for KCB
  - Homecoming will always be week before the break
  - Homecoming game will be the Thursday before, the dance the Saturday before
  - A week off encompasses two more Saturdays
  - At the height of marching band competition season, KCB would miss THREE weeks
  - Never have full set design, never have full competition show because won't have time
  - Impossible to run program by missing three Saturdays and not do a single contest and no rehearsals and then show up to Region the following Tuesday
  - No way for the program to run with those constraints on it
  - The week off is what it is and is no one's fault
  - Every year Mr. Winn tries to give as much information to incoming parents at February meeting
  - For next year: (if given football schedule in timely manner), let families know well ahead of time the days their child has band commitments and what days that leaves open to take a vacation
  - It affects other families and students when people decide to be gone during band commitments
  - At the end of the day it is about giving the band students the best experience
  - Moving forward (Mr. Winn already discussed with the principals), if he knows a student is going to be gone for two weekends in the middle of the season, he does not need to have a spot on the field for that student.
    - it affects everyone else, not just an individual family
    - communicate to incoming families
  - Teaching students how to work together and they need to show up
- Description of Region/Area Contest
  - Unable to plan ahead in calendar until the band has completed each level of performance
- Solo & Ensemble
  - Every student plays a solo
  - Directors help them pick
  - Students will order before Thanksgiving break
  - January will start coaching and working with piano player
  - February performance dates
  - Big driver of letter jacket points
  - Ensembles coordinated by students
- Winter Concert
  - No uniforms: formal/festive attire
  - Done by instrument classes (5 instrument classes, 5 performances)
- Reauditions for ensembles in December blind auditions
  - o 2 scales and All-State etude

- o counselors will help move schedule in January if necessary
- Happy to help answer questions if interested in board position or anything else
- Playoff games policy: if you're in town, you're expected to be there
